Works regularly for the creation and integration of video images in theatre and dance pieces. In recent years, his personal work has involved the synthesis of multiple screenings and the mixing of images in real time, either in a space or on the stage. He has participated in international video art festivals and recently took part as a film director in the group that presented the video installation Knight Riders at the old Palco factory in Petralona. Moreover, a play of his was staged at the National Theater's Experimental Stage.
